



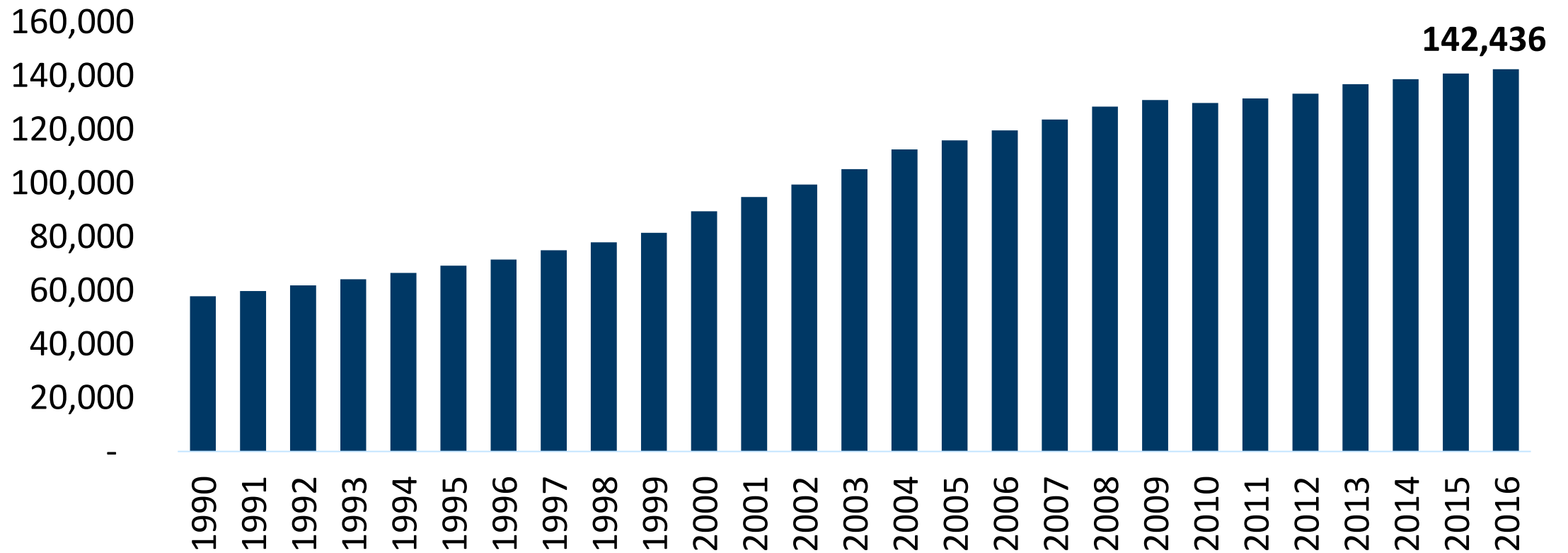

Growth Continues in Scott County

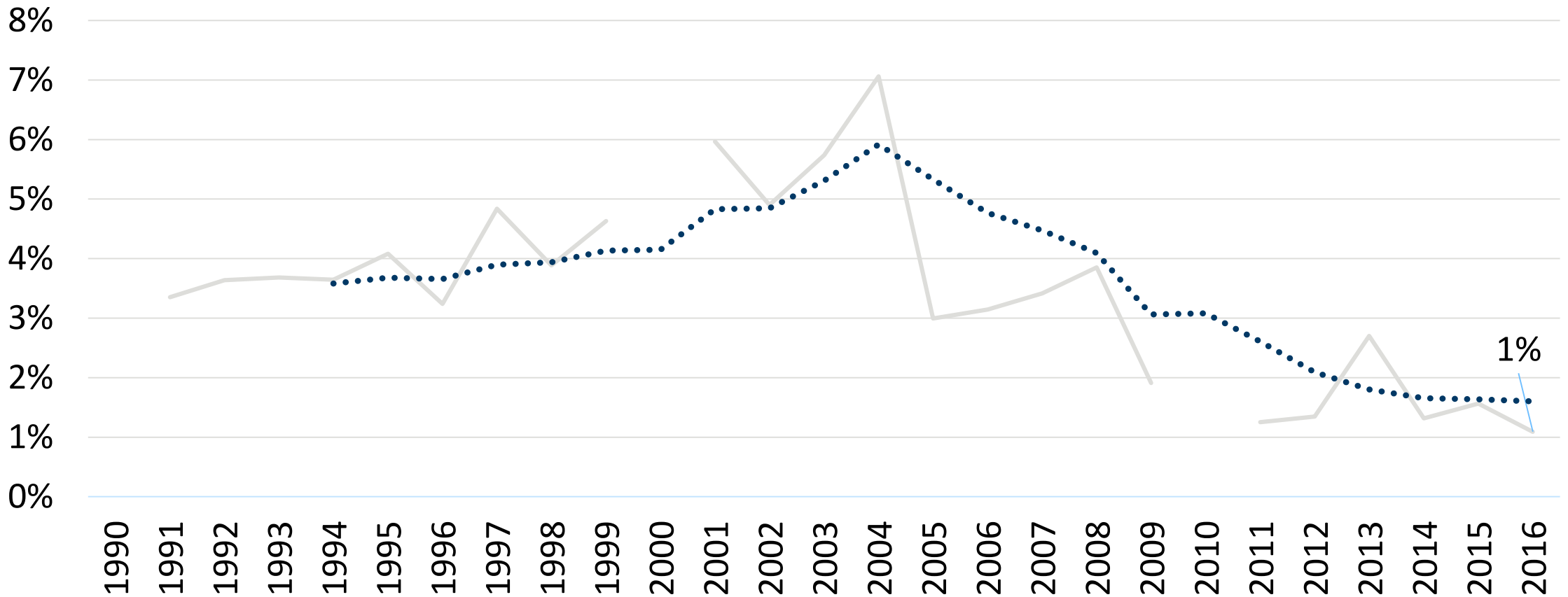
Scott County Total Population 1990-2016

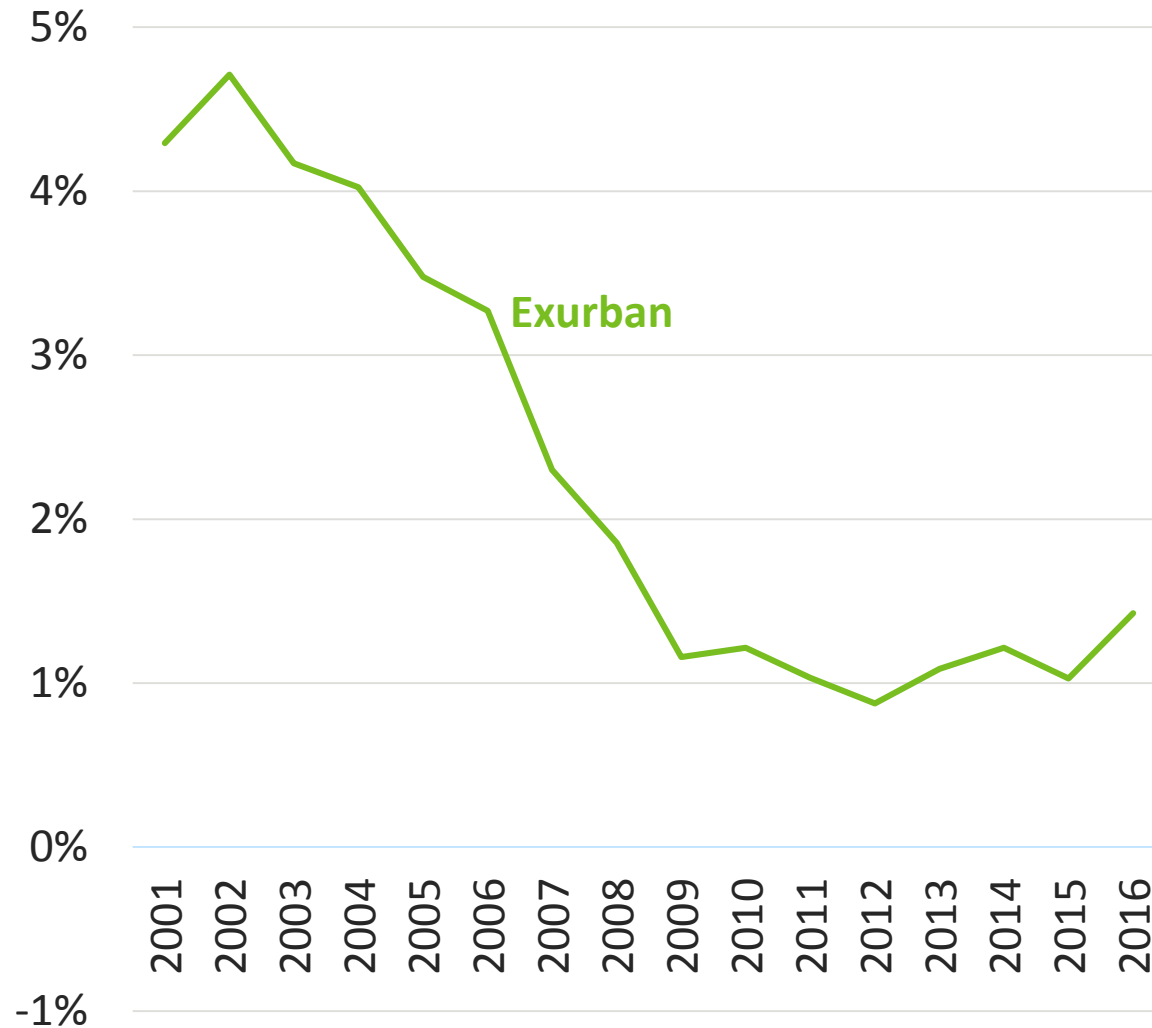
Growth has been more moderate in recent years

Scott County Annual Population Growth Rate 1990-2016



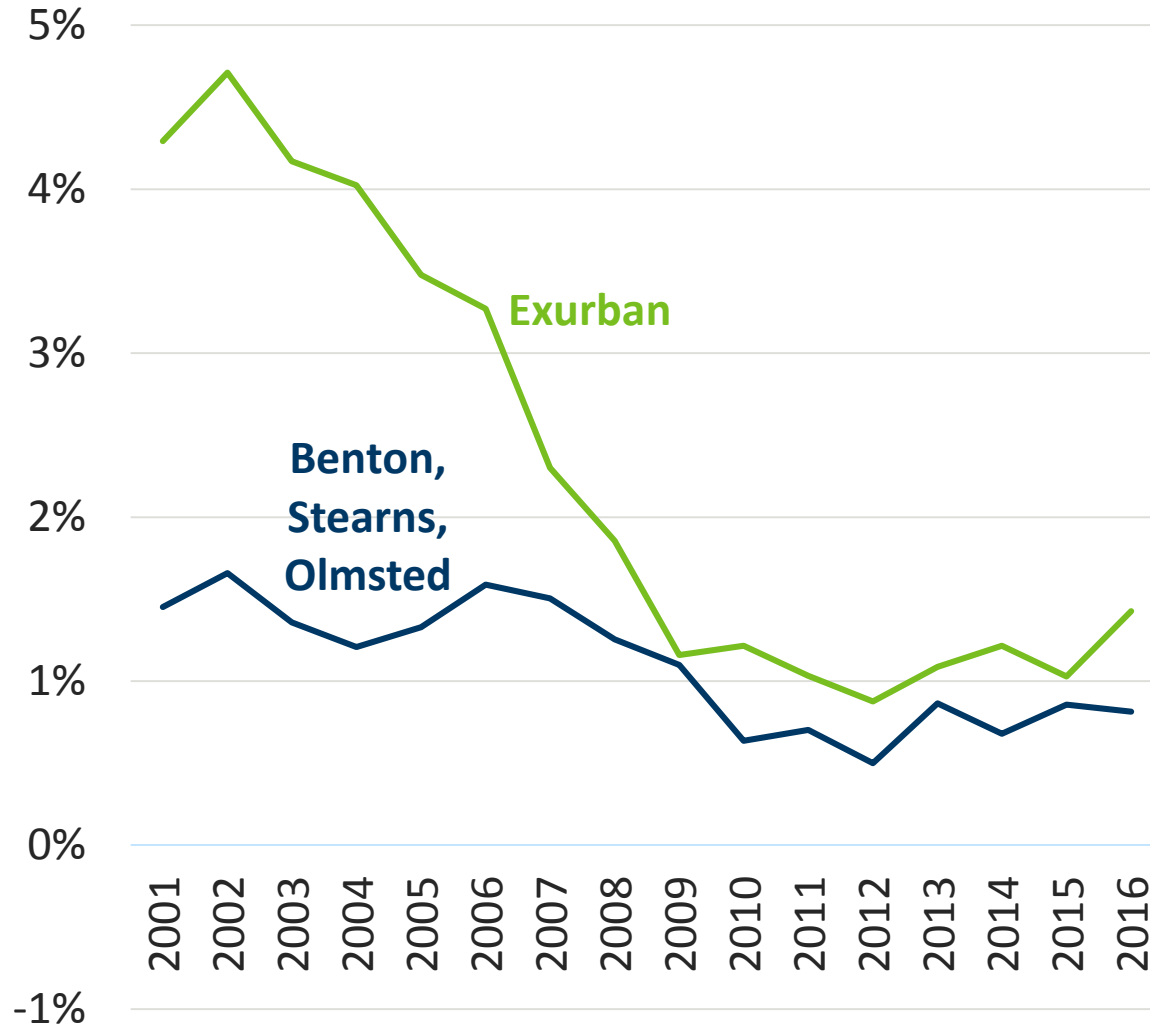

Exurban growth plummeted in the 2000s; gained equilibrium in the 2010s



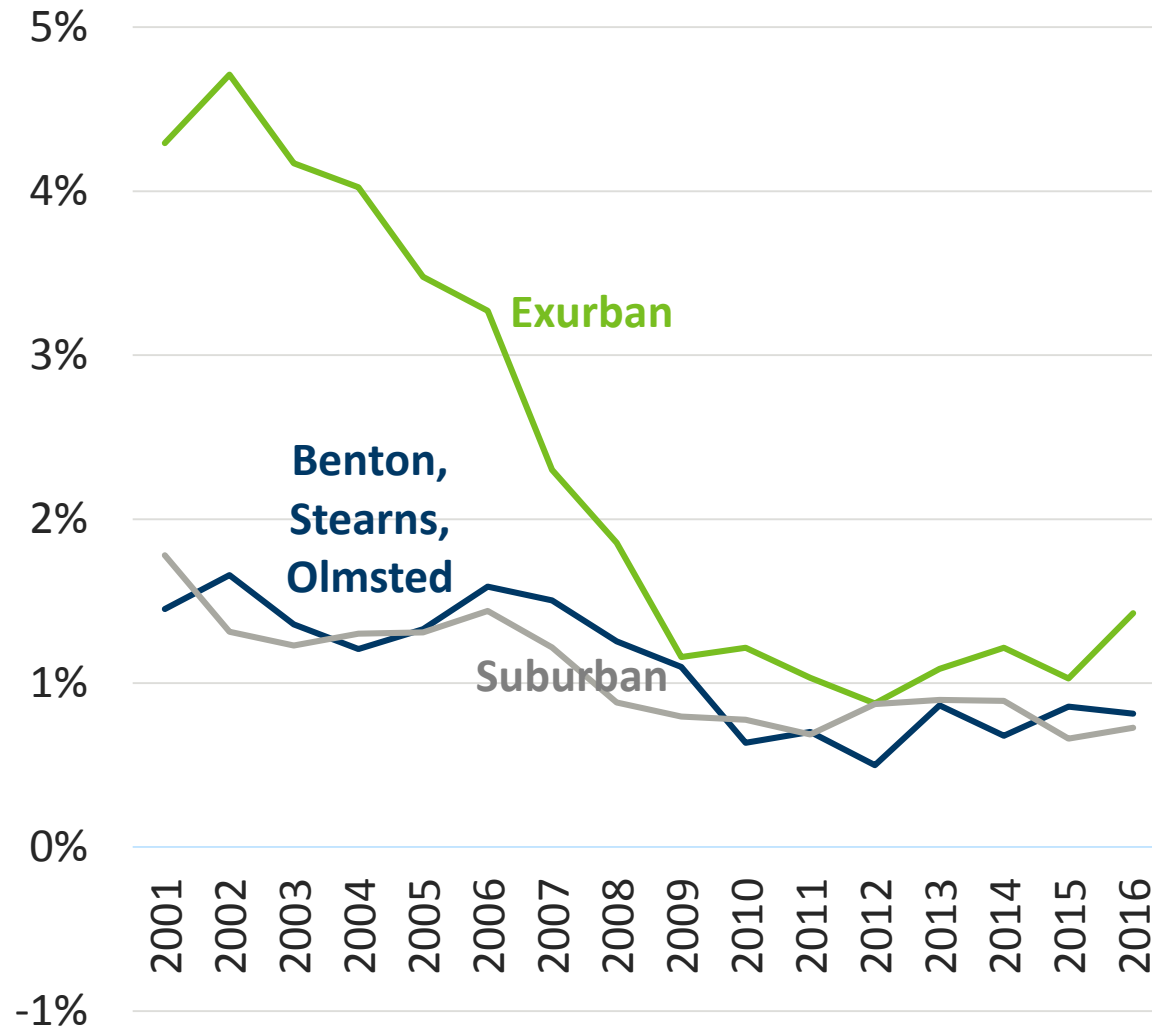

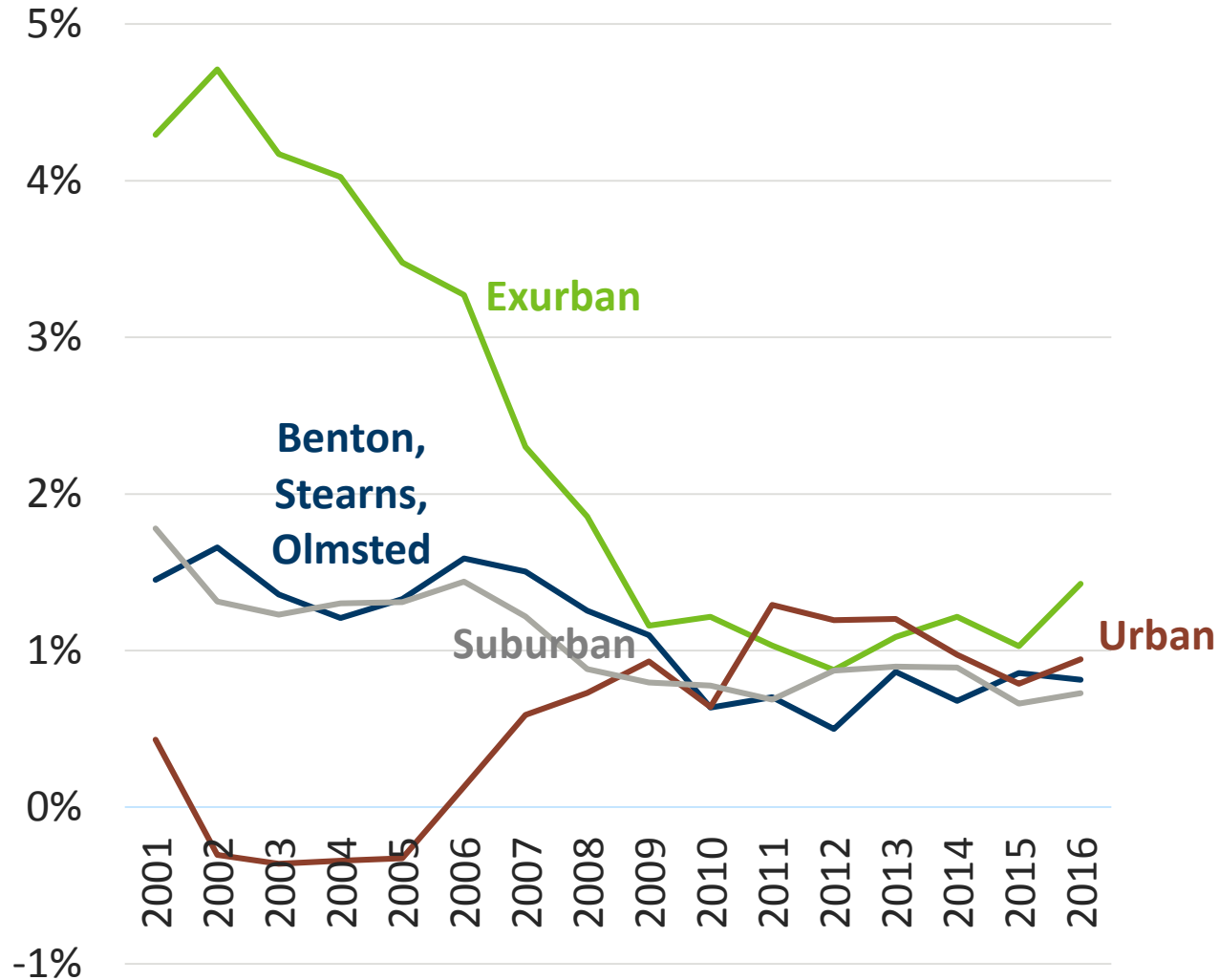
Suburban Twin Cities Counties similarly slowed; stabilized

Urban counties reversed a decades-long trend of little-to-no growth

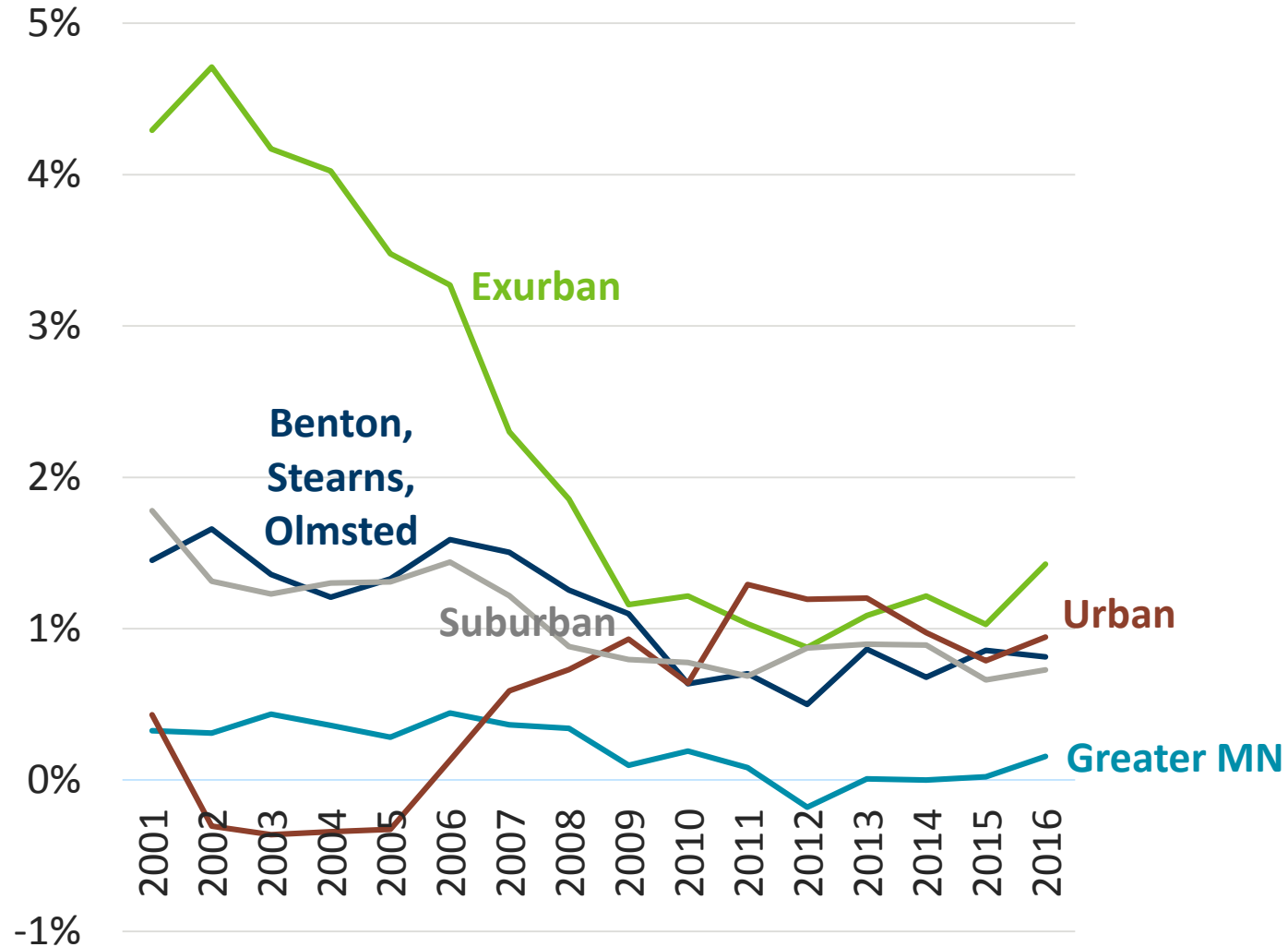

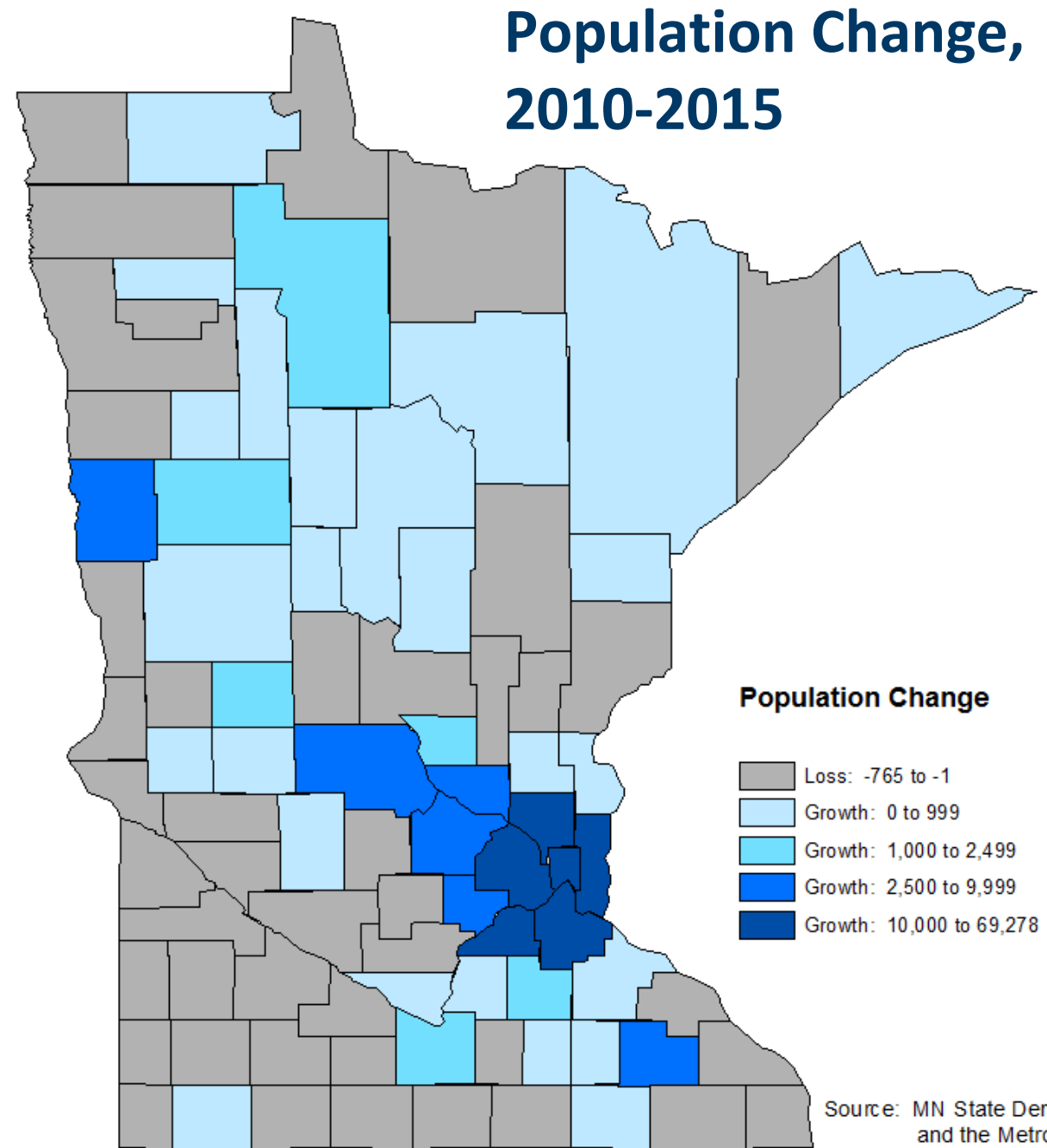

- Hennepin and Ramsey added 98,000 jointly



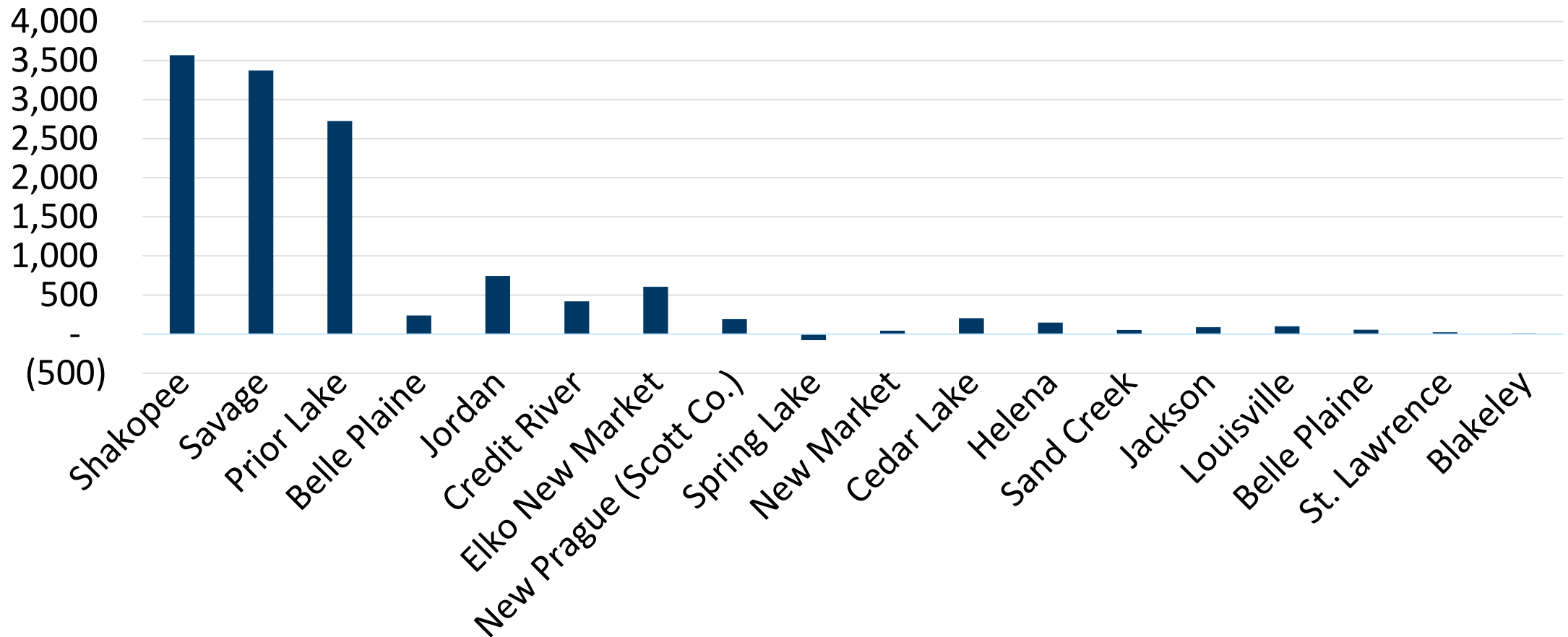

Growth of Scott County Cities 2010-2016

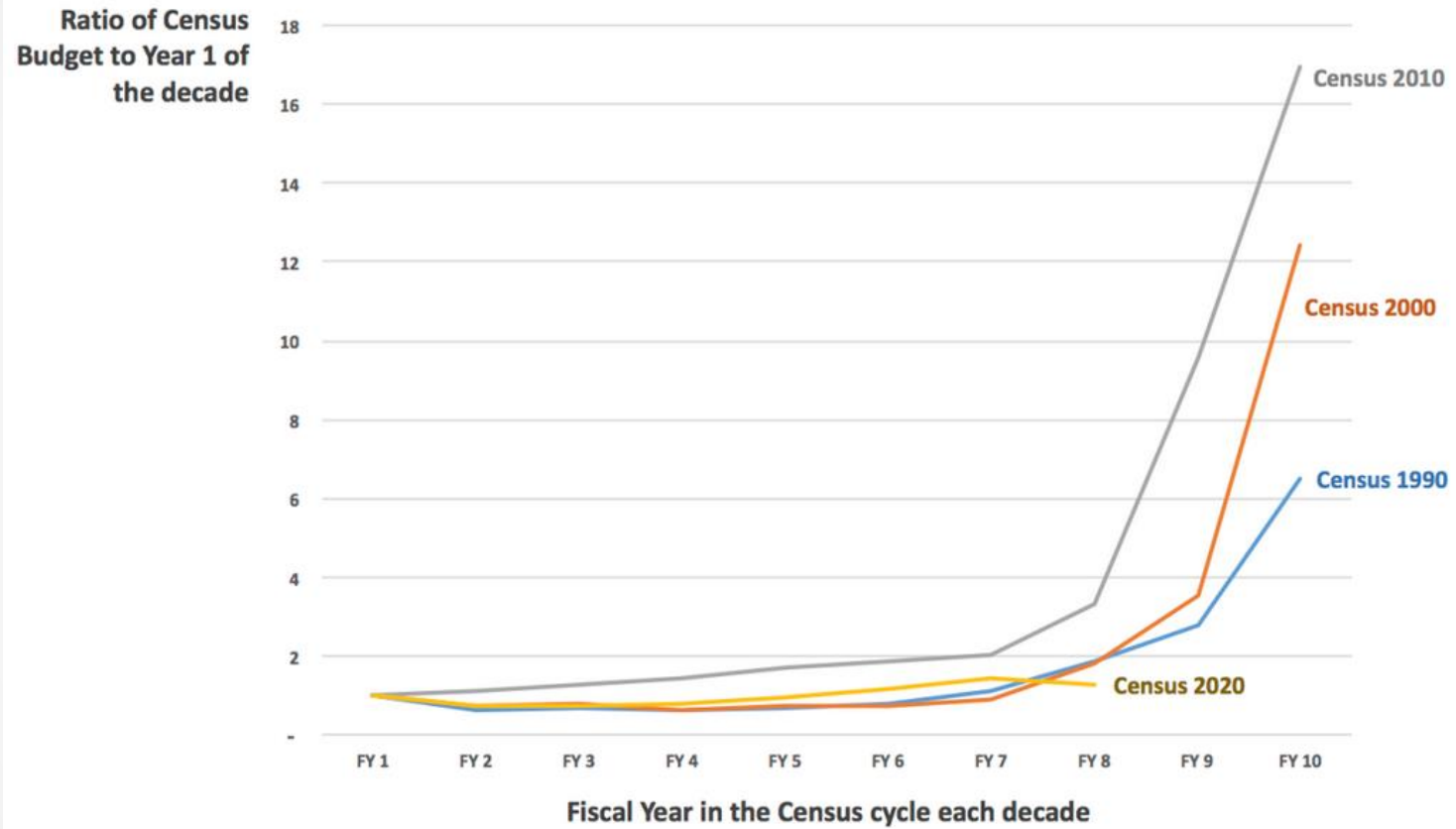

Spending during Four Census Decades

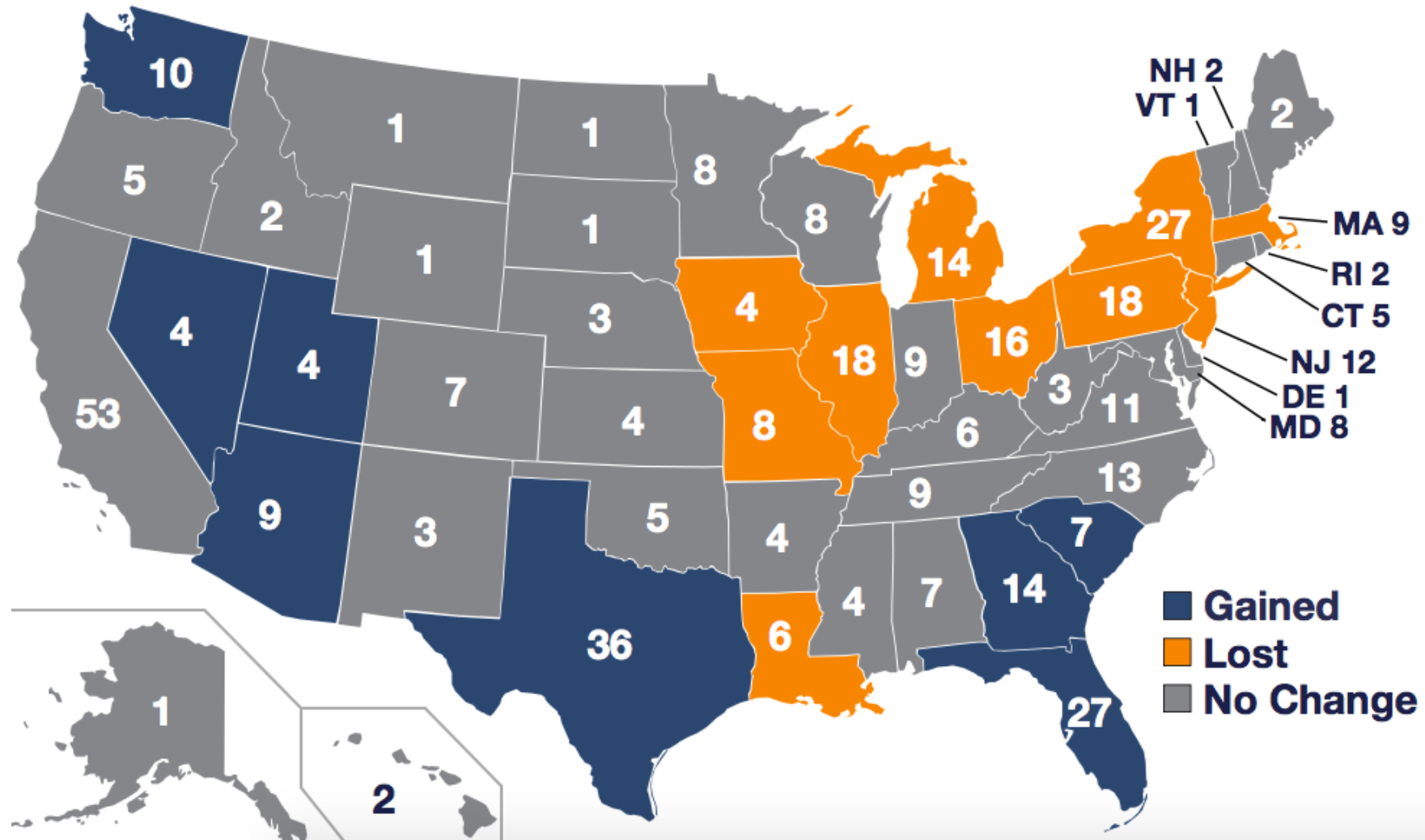

2010 Congressional Reapportionment



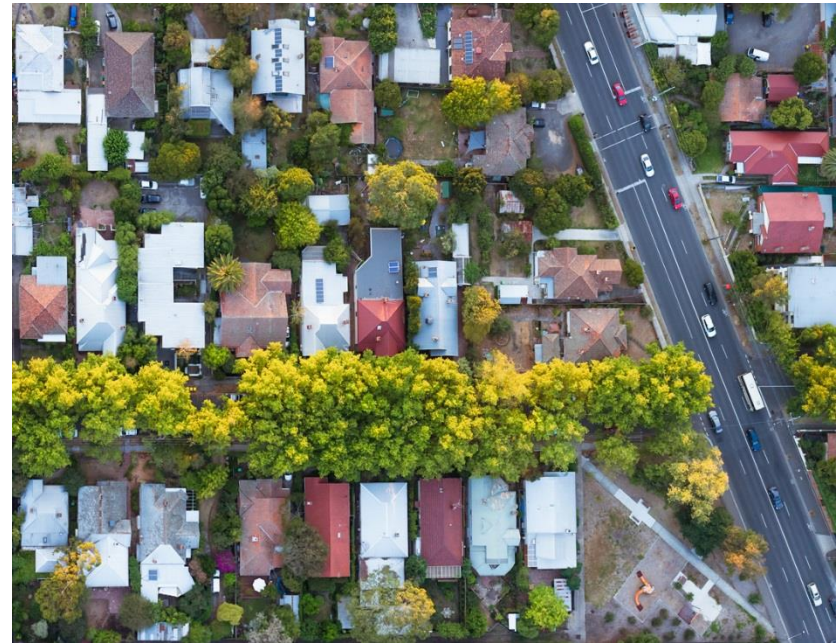
Census counts guide the distribution of dollars

- More than **400 billion** federal dollars are distributed to state and local governments **each year** on the basis of census data
- At least **\$1,532** per person is allocated by the federal government to Minnesota each year (that's **\$15,320** for the decade)



The 2020 Local Update of Census Addresses (LUCA) program

LUCA is the U.S. Census Bureau program that allows cities to review and comment on the addresses that will be used to conduct the 2020 Census.



LUCA: A little work could pay big dividends

- 1 new housing development with ~400 units and ~600 residents
- = ~ **\$8.4 million in federal funds to state and local governments between 2020 and 2030**



LUCA: What do you need to do to participate?

- Make sure your city is registered with the Census Bureau for the LUCA.
- Prioritize the LUCA work within your city. It's coming up quickly and has a brief review window. **Blink and you will miss it.**

In July 2017, your state will receive a formal invitation to participate in the 2020 Local Update of Census Addresses Operation (LUCA), as mandated by the Census Address List Improvement Act of 1994 (Public Law 103-430). This is the only opportunity offered to tribal, state, and local governments to review the U.S. Census Bureau's residential address list prior to the 2020 Census. The Census Bureau relies on a complete and accurate address list to reach every living quarters and associated population for inclusion in the census. Your LUCA participation can help ensure an accurate count for your state.

The primary purpose of the decennial census is to apportion the seats in the U.S. House of Representatives. However, over 1,000 federal programs utilize census data to allocate monies to tribal, state, and local governments. Census data support grant applications for funding community and regional development programs and projects, and can also help your state plan for future needs.

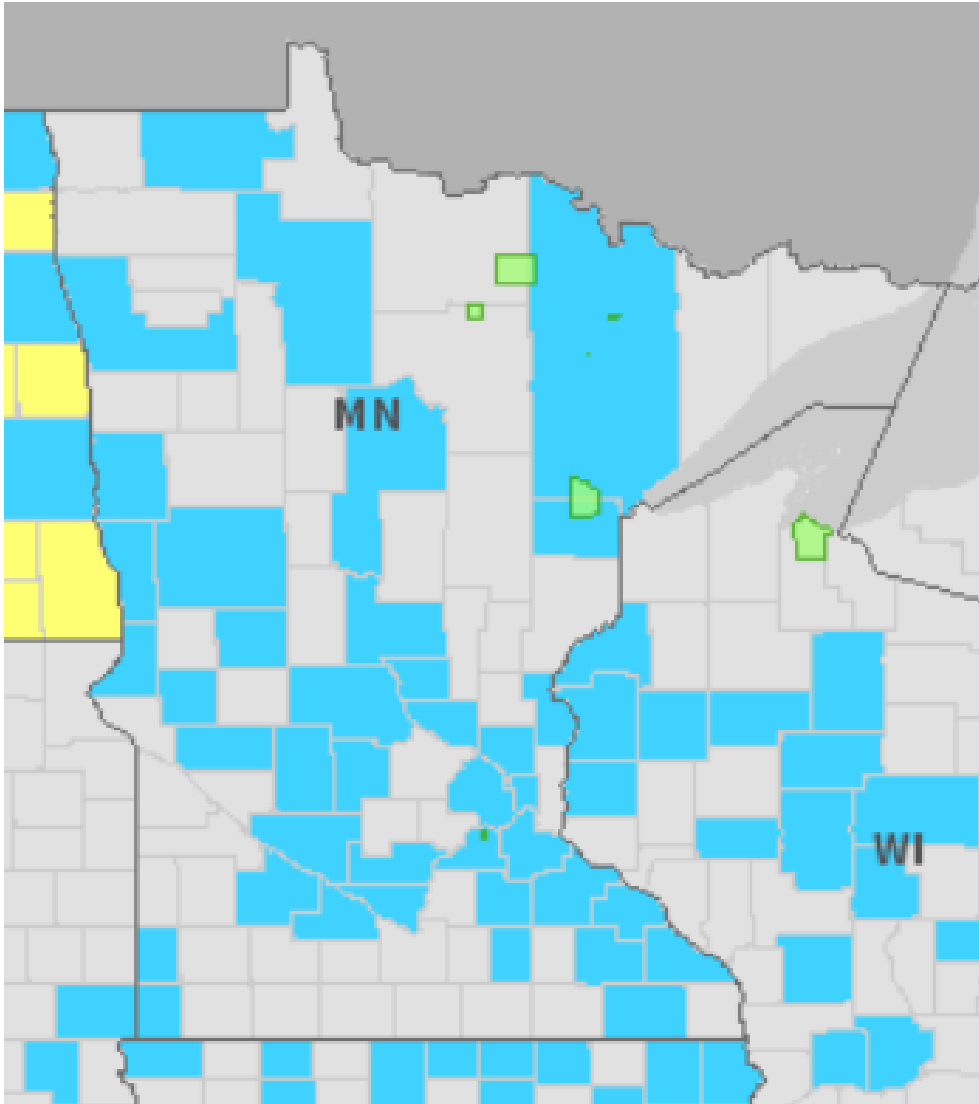

- Registration packets mailed to highest elected officials (e.g. Board Chairs) this month, July 2017
- Deadline to return register with the Census Bureau is December 15, 2017.
- Review period runs for 3 months; begins February 2018.

Bringing the LUCA home to Scott County

- The Census Bureau reports that they currently have **2,560** un-geocoded addresses in Scott County.
- That translates to about **\$11.3 million** in federal funding that state and local governments forgo **each year** between 2020 and 2030.
- Yikes. That's more than **1 billion dollars** over the course of the whole decade.
