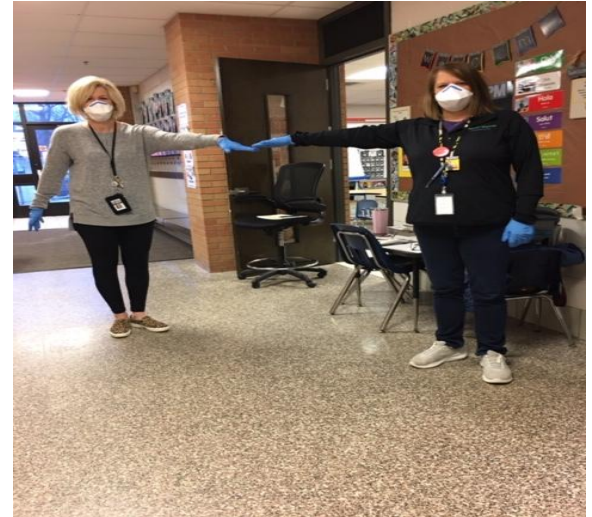

Meal Distribution

Goal: Continue to provide healthy and nutrition meals to children through curbside pickup and delivery

Locations: 31 sites

Meals served: 41,975 as of April 8, 2020

Pantry 191:

2003 bags 8 meals per bag to 6,959 individuals and distributed 854 boxes of fresh produce (July 1 - October 30, 2020 only) to 3,153 individuals

Brainpower -

15,265 bags (61,060 meals)

Goal: Provide high quality childcare for children of healthcare and emergency workers

Began Wednesday, March 18 and was free of charge.

- Care is provided from 6:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday
- Grades K-5 are at Gideon Pond Elementary and Hidden Valley Elementary.
- Children 6-weeks-old to five years are at Diamondhead Education Center.

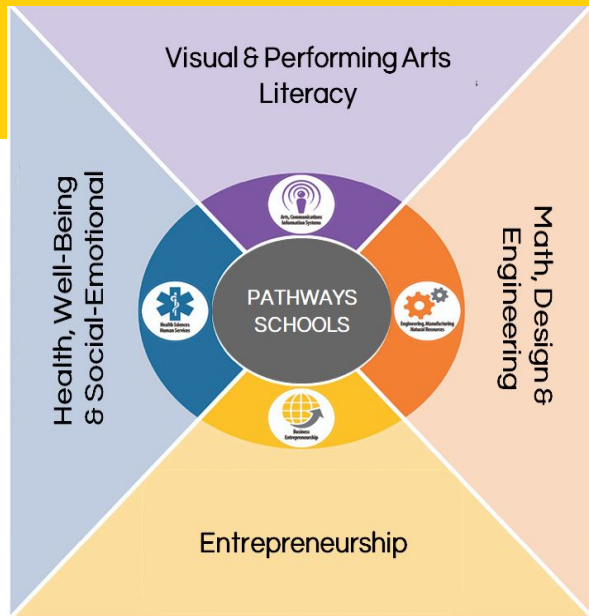
